1 WHAT'S THIS ALL ABOUT?

This sculpture brings together natural and made materials in a balanced and thoughtful way. The artist uses found objects like bark and driftwood alongside metal to create a sense of harmony and contrast.

It invites us to slow down, look closely and appreciate the textures and shapes that nature provides.

2 GET CREATING!

Use natural and recycled materials to create your own sculpture. Think about balance, texture and how different materials can work together.

You can build your sculpture vertically like this one, or try a different way of displaying your ideas!

3 WHAT YOU NEED:

- ★ Natural materials (sticks, bark, stones, seed pods, leaves etc.)
- ★ Recycled or found objects (metal bits, cardboard, wire etc.)
- ★ Strong glue or wire
- ★ A base or stand
- ★ Optional: paint, string, pliers



4 STEP BY STEP:

- 1 Collect your materials and choose a base for your sculpture.



- 2 Experiment with arranging your materials. Think about balance and how the shapes fit together.



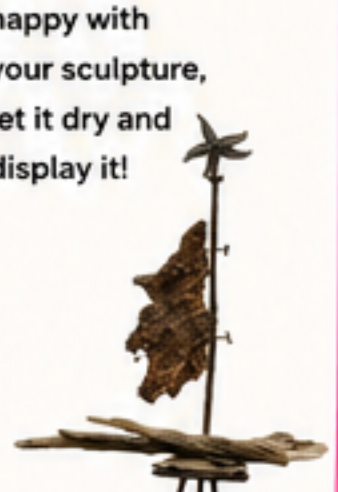
- 3 Start attaching your materials. Use glue or wire to secure them in place.



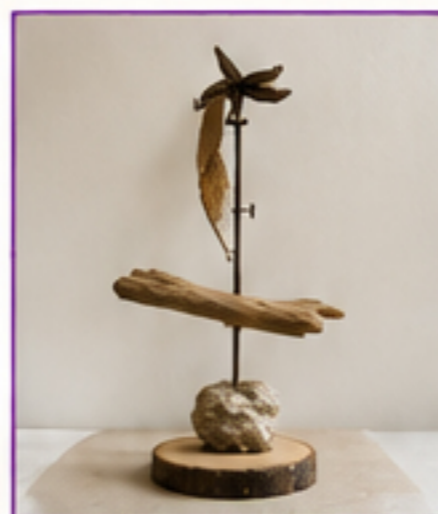
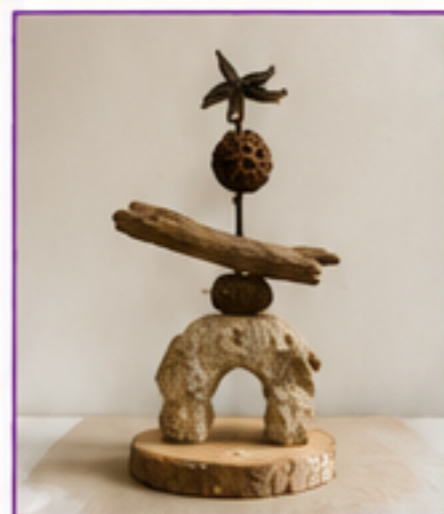
- 4 Keep adding and adjusting. Step back and look at your sculpture from different angles.



- 5 When you are happy with your sculpture, let it dry and display it!
